GOVERNING BOARD/COMMITTEE MEMBER APPLICATION

Thank you for your interest in applying for membership with the Liberty Tech Charter School (LTCS) Governing Board of Directors. The governing board of LTCS is accountable for the academic, financial, and operational policies of the school. The Governing Board approves all budgets, sets policies, approves selection of the Principal, and ensures the financial and administrative management of the school. The Board is led by a ten to twelve-voting, volunteer member Board.

We hope you will take this opportunity to learn more about LTCS by visiting our website at www.libertytechcharter.com. This application is the first step in becoming a new Board or Committee member. Touring the facility, interviewing, attending a Board meeting, serving on a Committee, and board approval are all steps of the process.

Time Commitment: The Board meets twelve times a year on the second Monday of the month for two hours starting at 7:00pm. Individuals should commit to a minimum of 15-20 hours each month, which include board meetings, committee meetings, and special events along with volunteering on various projects.

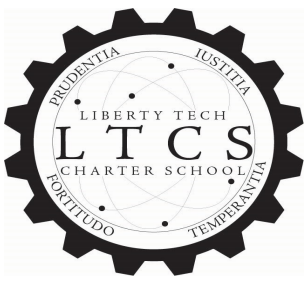
Board Terms: Board terms are for three years, with the ability to serve up to two consecutive three year terms upon approval.

Committees: The governing board has four committees: Academic, Development, Finance, and Governance. Each member is expected to serve on at least one committee.

Training: Each new member is responsible for receiving 15 hours of new board member training by State Charter School Commission and 9 hours each following year. This training assists in educating the board on its roles and responsibilities, along with maintaining compliance from GCSA.

GCSA Annual Conference: Each board member is expected to attend the Georgia Charter School Association (GCSA) Annual Conference, which provides more opportunity to network with other Charter Schools and to gather information that is beneficial to the success of the overall school.

Board Approval: prior to joining the Board each candidate is required to serve on a Board Committee for a minimum of three months. At the end of the three months the member may be considered for a role on the Board should a position be available or remain on the Committee, if so desired.

- ✓ Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and reside within the Metro Atlanta area.
- ✓ Applicants must attend one Board or Committee meeting prior to applying. If applying for a Committee, please see the school website LTCS Board section for respective committee meeting dates and times.
- ✓ Applicants must submit a background check from the Sheriff or Police Department within their County. As well as attend one of the schools Volunteer Training sessions offered throughout the school year.
- ✓ Only those applications which are submitted online will be accepted for review and consideration.
